Referral from your Doctor

If you are interested in a Sleep Studies appointment, a referral from your family doctor is not required.

If you are interested in a Pulmonary appointment, a referral from another doctor is not required, *but*, your medical records must be received in our office before your appointment date.

First Time Patients

We hope the following information will be of assistance.

Please download and complete the **Patient History Form** with as much detail as possible, prior to your appointment. You should plan to arrive 15 – 30 minutes early to complete any additional paperwork that may be necessary.

Also, please bring the following items to your appointment:

- Insurance card(s)
- Referral forms (if required)
- List of all medications you are taking – please include all inhalers, nebulizer medications, and over-the-counter medications
- Pertinent medical records
- Recent chest x-rays (within last 6 months) – if these were performed at Harris Regional Hospital, please let us know and we will gladly have them ready for your appointment
- Any required copayments

If you do not have a recent x-ray, please contact Karen in our office at 828-586-7994 and we will help arrange this for you before your appointment.
